California American Water Company (U210W) hereby submits for filing the following tariff sheets applicable to its Los Angeles District which are attached hereto:

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PURPOSE:

In accordance with Section 7.3.1 of the Water Industry Rules under General Order (GO) 96-B and section 454 of the Public Utilities Code, California American Water is seeking authority to offset Purchased Water Expenses it incurs from the various water wholesalers that supply water to its Los Angeles District Service Areas. These various water wholesalers recently increased rates to California American Water. California American Water requests that the full increase be offset in base rates to account for annual change in purchased water cost.

BACKGROUND:

California American Water serves approximately 27,600 customers in the Los Angeles Area, which includes Baldwin Hills, Duarte, and San Marino.

The increase in water rates resulted in a \$2,251,397 annual increase in purchased water expense to California American Water, plus a corresponding increase of \$11,574 in

uncollectible for a total increase of \$2,262,971. This increase is directly related to water consumption and thus should be applied to the quantity rate. The resulting final purchased water surcharge by service area is as follows:

REQUEST:

California American Water is requesting authorization to increase the quantity rates on its Baldwin Hills Service Area Customer by \$0.0182 for a new total of \$0.0451, on its Duarte Service Area Customers by \$0.0062 for a new total of \$0.0990, and on its San Marino Service Area by \$0.0617 for a new total of \$.0909 in order to properly recover the increased purchased water expense it incurs from all of the various water wholesalers that supply water to California American Water's Los Angeles Districts Service Areas.

The offset requested represents an increase of \$2,262,971 or 5.78% over the latest revenue requirement provided and approved by the Commission in D. 15-04-007.

Notice is not required prior to the effective date per General Order 96B, Water Industry Rule 7.3.1(7). California American Water will provide notice of the increase with implementation of the surcharge through bill message.

A **response** supports the filing and may contain information that proves useful to the Commission in evaluating the AL. A **protest** objects to the AL in whole or in part and must set forth the specific grounds on which it is based. These grounds² are:

- (1) The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
- (2) The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
- (3) The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
- (4) The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding; or
- (5) The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
- (6) The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.

A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

DWA must receive a response or protest via email (or postal mail) within 20 days of the date the AL is filed. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

Cities and counties that need Board of Supervisors or Board of Commissioners approval to protest should inform DWA, within the 20 day protest period, so that a late filed protest can be entertained. The informing document should include an estimate of the date the proposed protest might be voted on.

REPLIES³

The utility shall reply to each protest and may reply to any response. Any reply must be received by DWA within five business days after the end of the protest period, and shall be served on the same day on each person who filed the protest or response to the AL.

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.

Fees and Surcharges (Continued):

1. Per Advice Letter 1251, the under-collected balance in the Los Angeles County District Consolidated Expense Balancing Account (CEBA) will be recovered through a quantity based surcharge, as shown in the below table effective October 1, 2019. The total amount will be recovered from all classes of customers.

2. Water Revenue Adjustment Mechanism (WRAM) and Modified Cost Balancing Account (MCBA) Surcharges.
 - a. For the **Baldwin Hills** service area, a surcharge is included on each bill to recover the net under-collection in the WRAM and MCBA of \$6,875,810, including interest, as of December 31, 2018. The surcharge of \$0.1694 per 100 gallons is set to recover the under-collection at a rate equal to 15% of the authorized revenue requirement as approved by D.18-12-021.
 - b. For the **Duarte** service area, a surcharge is included on each bill to recover the net under-collection in the WRAM and MCBA of \$9,179,656, including interest, as of December 31, 2018. The surcharge of \$0.0833 per 100 gallons is set to recover the under-collection at a rate equal to 15% of the authorized revenue requirement as approved by D.18-12-021.
 - a. For the **San Marino** service area, a surcharge is included on each bill to recover the net under-collection in the WRAM and MCBA of \$18,0285,324, including interest, as of December 31, 2018. The surcharge of \$0.0333 per 100 gallons is set to recover the under-collection at a rate equal to 15% of the authorized revenue requirement as approved by D.18-12-021.
3. A surcharge is applied to each bill to offset increases in purchase water costs for the Los Angeles County District.
