**Purpose:**

This advice letter filing requests recovery of intervenor compensation awarded to Monterey County Landwatch.

**Background:**

In Decision (“D.”) 20-02-060, Monterey County Landwatch was awarded compensation for contribution in connection with D.18-09-017, which granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity for California American Water Company’s Monterey Peninsula Water Supply Project, including a 6.4 million-gallon-per-day desalination plant.

After issuance of D.18-09-017, Monterey County Landwatch requested intervenor compensation. In D.20-02-060, the Commission granted Salinas Valley Water Coalition’s request and ordered the following:

1. *Landwatch - Monterey County shall be awarded \$104,796.50.*
2. *Within 30 days of the effective date of this decision, California-American Water Company shall pay LandWatch Monterey County the total award. Payment of the award shall include compound interest at the rate earned on prime, three-month non-financial commercial paper as reported in Federal Reserve Statistical Release H.15, beginning January 31, 2019, the 75th day after the filing of LandWatch Monterey County’s request, and continuing until full payment is made.<sup>1</sup>*

On March 30, 2020, California American Water issued a payment of \$107,254.57, which includes interest to Monterey County Landwatch in accordance with D.20-02-060. California American Water over-estimated the interest payment to Monterey County Landwatch. The total payment should have been \$107,231.63, no further action will be taken on this matter.

**Request:**

California American Water requests authorization to bill customers a meter surcharge to recover the \$107,254.57 compensation award for the Monterey County Landwatch from all customer classes in the Monterey Service Area as ordered by D.20-02-060.

1. The utility did not properly serve or give notice of the AL;
2. The relief requested in the AL would violate statute or Commission order, or is not authorized by statute or Commission order on which the utility relies;
3. The analysis, calculations, or data in the AL contain material error or omissions;
4. The relief requested in the AL is pending before the Commission in a formal proceeding;  
or
5. The relief requested in the AL requires consideration in a formal hearing, or is otherwise inappropriate for the AL process; or
6. The relief requested in the AL is unjust, unreasonable, or discriminatory, provided that such a protest may not be made where it would require relitigating a prior order of the Commission.
7. A protest may not rely on policy objections to an AL where the relief requested in the AL follows rules or directions established by statute or Commission order applicable to the utility. A protest shall provide citations or proofs where available to allow staff to properly consider the protest.

DWA must receive a response or protest via email (**or** postal mail) within 20 days of the date the AL is filed. When submitting a response or protest, **please include the utility name and advice letter number in the subject line.**

The actions requested in this advice letter are not now the subject of any formal filings with the California Public Utilities Commission, including a formal complaint, nor action in any court of law.

This filing will not cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules or rules.
